DETAILS ON NEW LEISURE VENUE RELEASED

CurveMotion, the new Bury St Edmunds based interactive leisure venue, has announced details of the facilities and activities it will be offering the people of East Anglia when it opens its doors early next month.

The exciting new venue will offer visitors a range of high quality, carefully designed facilities, including a high specification indoor play area and frame for children under 12 (complete with a separate area for the under 5's), a sports arena, mega slides and a rollerskating rink. CurveMotion will also have a restaurant, offering high quality, nutritious meals and snacks made from locally sourced produce, and separate party areas.

The play frame for children is expected to be the largest in East Anglia and will incorporate a separate sensory based soft play area for babies who are not yet walking; as well as a climbing wall, an interactive sliding snakes and ladders game, a sports arena, a ball and cannon battle zone, a hang tough activity and a disco area for toddlers to 12 year olds.

The rollerskating arena will be open to all ages and abilities, and will offer different skating sessions, roller discos and theme nights. CurveMotion's "Big Night Out" on Friday nights will be a popular club night particularly aimed at teenagers, and will be hosted by established DJ's, with both skating and dancing on offer.

CurveMotion has also released details of skating lessons on its website. The lessons start on 30th April 2011, run for 10 weeks, include skate hire and are available to suit all ages and abilities from 5 years old.

The venue is also now taking party bookings over its website at www.curvemotion.com, where you can opt from a variety of packages from a toddler play party, to a skate night party for those aged over 13. The packages are inclusive of entertainment, invitations, venue and refreshments, and the organisers say many bookings have already been taken.

Sarah Stamp, Spokesperson for CurveMotion said: "We have had a tremendous amount of interest via the website and also our pages on Twitter and Facebook, where people can sign up to receive regular updates and special offers. The venue is going to be a great, fun place where you can spend time with family and friends and keep fit at the same time. Our aim is to provide a high quality venue, which has something for all age groups."
