POPULAR LEISURE VENUE TO PAY TRIBUTE TO WELL LOVED LOCAL DJ

CurveMotion, the Bury St Edmunds based family interactive leisure venue, has announced that it will be holding a tribute night on Saturday 8th October for popular Bury based DJ, Adi Linton, who tragically lost his long battle with cancer at the beginning of August.

Mr Linton had been involved with the venue since it opened in April this year, and regularly DJ'd for rollerdisco sessions, particularly for the over 18's Wednesday night "Skate Invaders" where he had a dedicated following of fans.

The evening will be called "And the Beat Goes On", a reference to the Whispers song that Mr Linton had chosen to be played at his funeral, and will be a celebration of his life, and a chance to share memories.

Sarah Stamp, Spokesperson for CurveMotion explains: "Adi was such a local legend from his time DJing at Rollerbury, so when we opened he was the natural choice to join our team and share that experience. He had so many ideas on how to make the venue a success, and his energy and passion for music was contagious. Since he passed away we have been literally flooded with requests from people who knew Adi and who wanted a chance to celebrate his life and the contribution he had made to rollerskating in Bury St Edmunds, so this seems to be the perfect way to do that – bringing together happy memories of him with the music and rollerskating he was so known for."

The night will run from 6pm to 10pm, and is open to all ages. Guests are welcome to come in 80's themed fancy dress if they choose, and well known DJ's who worked alongside Mr Linton over the years will be on hand to provide the music. There will be a memory line for posting memories of him; and CurveMotion will also be running a raffle, which they are asking everyone who attends to consider bringing a prize for. The proceeds of the raffle will be donated to the ward at Addenbrookes where Mr Linton received his care.
